#### **FUN WITH LITERACY - JULY HOLIDAYS**





During the July holiday period, LTL hosted its termly holiday programme at 4 different schools including Bontebok Primary, Cypress Primary, St Augustine's Primary and Vorentoe Primary. 70 learners participated! The focus for this programme was on reading and writing while learners had fun working at educational stations based on fine & gross motor skills development.

The average for the baseline assessment was 56% while the final assessment showed a 32% increase, reaching a high of 88%!

LTL's literacy programme shows the effectiveness even during the holiday programmmes.
