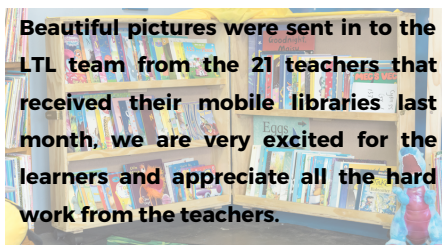
SUCCESS STORY OF BLAKE KAPIERA
